

# **BUILDING INSTRUCTION FURNITURE**

CLEVER CARDBOARD CREATIONS

#### Armchair / 2-seater / 3-seater sofa

1,2 or 3 boxes for seat(s)	60cm wide x 60cm deep x 40cm high
1,2 or 3 boxes for backrest(s)	60cm wide x 20cm deep x 74cm high
2 boxes for armrest	80cm wide x 15cm deep x 60cm high
1 Cover in the ordered colour	


Step 1: Close the required boxes separately with tape. Armchair 4 boxes | 2- seater 6 boxes | 3-seater 8 boxes

Step 2: Group the boxes into an armchair / couch.

Step 3: Pull the fabric cover over.

(Tip: The CUBIQZ label is always on the front of the right armrest.)

Optional - Use small pins in the corners of the seat to fix the fabric. Iron the fabric cover when it has been pulled over the boxes.





# Cabinet / TV-cabinet

1 box	90cm wide x 50cm deep x 45 cm high
1 printed panel with velcro strips	Printed panel white or wood look
1 cross	Two cardboard plates slide into each other
4 plastic feet	Optional

Step 1: Close the box on one side. Start with the two equal flaps, then fold the small flap inwards. As the final step, close the box by using the tabs.

Step 2: Slide the two plates into a cross. Now push this cross into the opening of the box. Close the box as described in step 1 *Optional - glue the four legs in the corners.* 

Step 3: Rotate the box 180 degrees


(Tip: press the box in the middle while turning so that the cross does not shift).

Step 4: Mount the fluffy circles (with loops) with the adhesive side at the designated positions on the panel. (see additional info sheet). Then fit the crude circles (with barbs) **ON** the fluffy circles that have already been mounted.

Place the panel on the box and press the velcro firmly.

Optional: For higher cabinets, the boxes can be stacked Note: with stacked products, there will only be a cross in the top box









## Dinner table

1 table top	90cm wide x 90cm deep x 10cm high
2 boxes for leg	60cm wide x 20cm deep x 74cm high
1 cardboard plate	It's already on the table top


Step 1: Close the boxes for the leg separately with transparant tape. Close the table top with the double-sided tape. Leave the supplied plate in the table top, this serves as reinforcement.

(Tip: Place the tabletop on a flat surface while closing, so the tabletop will be straight.)

Step 2: Stick the two boxes for the leg together.

Note: Use tape only on the top and bottom of the leg. Otherwise this will be visible.

Step 3: ow slide the plat with the opening over the leg.




Inside the box there is a brown plate. please leave it inside, it is for extra security. Please place the box on a flat ground while closing!

# Pillar


1 box	28cm wide x 28cm deep x 80cm high
1 cross	Two cardboard plates slide into each other

Step 1: Close the box using the double-sides tape. Note the order of the flaps as indicated on then drawing.

Step 2: slide the two plates into a cross. Push the cross into the opening of the box







# **Fireplace**

Necessities for the pillar	
1 box	28cm wide x 28 cm deep x 80cm high
1 cross	Two cardboard plates slide into each oth

Necessities for the fireplace	e	
2 pillars	28cm wide x 28cm deep x 80cm high	
1 upper box	116cm wide x 28cm deep x 15cm high	
1 box with flame	80cm wide x 15cm deep x 60cm high	

Step 1: Close the box using the double-sided tape. Note the order of the flaps as indicated on the drawing.

Step 2: Slide the two plates into a cross. Push this cross into the opening of the box.

Step 3: Close the boxes separately with the double-sided tape. Close the box with flame with transparent tape.

Tip: place the upper box on a flat surface while closing.

Step 4: Group the boxes into a fire. Secure the boxes with the help of the double-sided tape


Optional - Stick the boxes at the back of the fireplace with transparent tape for extra strength.



# Coffee table / hocker

1 box	60cm wide x 6ocm deep x 40cm high
1 cross	Two cardboard plates slide into each other
1 fabric cover	Optional

Step 1: close the box using the double-sided tape. Note the order of the flaps as indicated on the drawing.


Step 2: Slide the two plates into a cross. Push this cross into the opening of the box.

Step 3: (only for the hocker): Pull the fabric cover over. (Tip: Align the cover with the corners and then pull down the cover evenly.



### Side table / nightstand / hocker


1 box	45cm wide x 45cm deep x 45cm high
1 cross	Two cardboard plates slide into each other
1 fabric cover	Optional


Step 1: Close the box using the double-sided tape. Note the order of the flaps as indicated on the drawing.

Step 2: Slide the two plates into a cross. Push this cross into the opening of the box.

Step 3: (only for the hocker): Pull the fabric cover over. (Tip: Align the cover with the corners and then pull down the cover evenly.)







Optional



Bed

4 boxes bed	90cm wide x 50cm deep x 45cm high
1 headboard	90cm wide x 10cm deep x 90cm high

Step 1: Close the box on one side. Close the box by using the tabs.

Step 2: Close the headboard with the double-sided tape.

(Tip: Place the box flat on a flat surface while closing, so the headbord will be straight.)

Step 3: Shape the boxes into a bed. (The boxes are 50cm long and form a total length of 200cm. By tilting the boxes 1/4 a size of 180cm can be made.)

Tip 1: The boxes are 50cm deep and 45cm high. By tilting the box, a different bed size can be made.

Tip 1: Attach the boxes together with transparent tape.

Tip 2: Dress the bed with bedding










Step 2



Fit the crude circles (with barbs) ON the fluffy circles that have already been mounted.





First place the front of the panel on the box. If it is positioned correctly, then place the top on the box and press the panel (the Velcro) firmly.
